The Global Inventory of NQFs captures, records and analyses global trends in qualifications frameworks.


- A collaborative production, covering the globe together: Unesco, UIL, Cedefop, ETF. This is our 6th edition.
- It includes two volumes:
 - **Volume I:** Thematic chapters
 - Volume II: Country Case Studies
- **Inventory:** informs decisions by ministries, authorities and other stakeholders, shares knowledge with global network of experts and officials implementing national qualifications frameworks (NQFs).
- The last volume (2022) featured 93 case studies of NQFs from around the world.
- We are currently data collection of the upcoming edition (Volume II) .

Research questions addressed:


- How are NQFs progressing globally?

Volume II: Structure Of The Country Chapters




2022 Reports included in the analysis by world regions






NQF objectives








NQF stages reached worldwide




Types of qualifications included










Validation of non-formal and informal learning

VNFIL – use of NQF




Challenges to NQF development and implementation








Enablers of NQF development and implementation
